Facilities

The various surgical facilities are: General Orthopaedics Surgeries, Medical and surgical treatment of arthritis, Joint replacements of the knee, hip, shoulder and elbow, Fibreoptic arthroscopy of various joints, treatment of fractures, non-union and malunion of fractures, ligament injuries, reconstructive surgeries, specialized Ilizarov surgery (limb lengthening procedure), Correction of deformities, Spinal surgeries (disc problems such as prolapse disc, spondylolisthesis, pinched nerves, spine fractures, deformities, scoliosis and tumours), Paediatric Orthopaedics, Industrial injuries , brachial plexus repair, hand and microvascular surgeries
