

## PHYSIOLOGY

Department of Physiology is a well established department for both undergraduate and post graduate courses. Every year there is intake of 150 undergraduate students and 2 post graduate students. Department has experienced and competent faculty as per MCI requirement who are dedicated to teaching.

At undergraduate level, apart from traditional teaching methods like lectures, tutorials and practicals modern methods like computer assisted learning by using educational CDs are employed. Teaching and examination schedule is provided to the students at beginning of the term. Seminars, guest lectures and quiz programmes are also arranged to facilitate learning. Regular formative assessment by way of MCQ test and vivas is done. Problem based learning is implemented in the syllabus. Paper discussion of all theory examinations is conducted regularly. Extra coaching is provided to academically backward students. Intensive coaching programme is run just prior to university examination to improve examination skills. Through ward teacher system students' progress is monitored and counseling and guidance is provided by the teacher.
