PULMONARY MEDICINE

The Department Of Pulmonary Medicine was established in 1990 . Presently teaching is being imparted to undergraduate students doing MBBS course . Teaching is in form of bedside clinics , classroom lecturers , tutorials & workshops.

Postgraduate MD course is likely to commence in next academic year subject to MCI approval .

Salient Features:

There is adequate faculty in the Dept. Pulmonary Function testing & bronchoscopy is being done. We are part of GAIL's Air Pollution Related Respiratory Diseases Diagnostic Center. We also have a well equipped ICU for intensive respiratory care with invasive & non invasive ventilators.

DOTs is being imparted under RNTCP. We have a special asthma clinic & smoking cessation clinic being conducted weekly.

Ongoing Research Projects:

- 1) Evaluation of efficacy of DOTS in the Medical College setup. With special ref to patient compliance, drug toxicity, relapse.
- 2) Morbidity profiling of Pune Citizens with special reference to Air Pollution Related Respiratory Diseases through the APRRDDC (Air Pollution Related Respiratory Diseases Diagnostic Center) sponsored by GAIL.
