

# **Induction Program**

The Induction Programme for the Batch 2023-2024 was conducted at IMED from July 10th to July 29th, 2023, in accordance with AICTE norms and UGC quality mandates (Diksharambh). The objectives of the Induction Programme are as follows:

- Welcoming students to higher education and preparing them for their new roles.
- Assisting students in adjusting and feeling comfortable in their new academic environment.
- Instilling the ethos and culture of IMED among the students.
- Introducing students to a broader sense of purpose and encouraging self-exploration. The orientation programme encompasses the introduction of Bharati Vidyapeeth, campus facilities, faculty, syllabus overview, corporate resource center, alumni interactions, guest talks from corporates and entrepreneurs, as well as providing counseling sessions on anti-drug and antiragging measures.

#### Day-1

On July 10th, 2023, Mr. Yogesh Pawar, a renowned Motivational Speaker and the Founder of the School of Inspiration Leadership, served as the resource person for the day. He delivered an insightful session on various aspects including creativity, expectations, process, information, and wisdom. Encouraging students with the mantra of perseverance, he emphasized the importance of persistence and urged them not to give up easily. Mr. Pawar also introduced three key behaviors for success: relevance, commitment, and the ability to engage with others effectively. Furthermore, he highlighted the significance of acquiring relevant information and intelligence in pursuit of one's goals and aspirations.

Mr. Aniruddha Suryawanshi, a devoted government official for the Government of India since June 2019, served in the Indian Army for over 19 years, starting in July 2004. With his strong leadership skills honed through military service, he contributes significantly to national defense from Pune, Maharashtra, for the past four years and two months.

During his session, Mr. Suryawanshi highlighted India's current state in 2023, expressing his vision for the nation to become a global leader. He emphasized addressing pollution, especially severe in New Delhi due to vehicle emissions, advocating for widespread adoption of electric cars. Additionally, he addressed poverty, envisioning a self-sufficient India where everyone escapes poverty's grasp.

Additionally, Mr. Suryawanshi discussed the 2047 trajectory, focusing on emerging technologies like AI, IoT, and Data Analytics. He also provided insights on navigating professional challenges and coping with threats in the professional sphere.

#### Day 2:

On July 11th, 2023, Mr. Eun Kyung Ki, a distinguished professional hailing from South Korea, graced the session as the invited resource person. With a remarkable background and vast experience, he has made noteworthy contributions in quality inspection, manufacturing audit, and supplier development throughout his career.

He provided a brief overview of the emerging market collaboration between India and Korea, highlighting:

- 4. Collaboration prospects in the education sector between India and Korea.

She urged practicality in life and stressed the importance of networking in the corporate world. Additionally, Mr. Preetam Tiwari, Co-founder & Director of Incub Xperts, shared valuable advice on entrepreneurship, highlighting the risks involved and the necessity of prudent budgeting and technological awareness. He drew from his own experiences to impart lessons and encouraged students to present feasible business plans to investors while considering technological advancements.



Mr. Binit Singh, Senior Manager of Talent Management at Reliance Retail, shared his personal journey in the Human Resources field, emphasizing the importance of ethics in organizational success. He discussed key aspects essential for a career in HR, including communication gap, grapevine errors, diversity and inclusion, lying, bullying, theft, persons with disabilities, background verification, tokenism, LGBT regulations, and performance management systems. Drawing from his experiences, he acquainted students with current HR trends to enhance their understanding of the field.

#### Day 7

On July 24th, 2023, guest speakers Mr. Vishal Methi, Dr. Sanjay Gandhi, and Dr. Anirban Sarkar shared valuable insights during Entrepreneurs Day. Mr. Methi, founder of J4E (Just For Entrepreneurs), aimed to create a supportive platform for entrepreneurs. He emphasized the importance of building teams, people management, and consistency in achieving

success. Dr. Gandhi, CMD of Aspire Knowledge And Skills India Pvt Ltd, provided entrepreneurship tips and highlighted qualities of successful entrepreneurs. Dr. Sarkar, a first-generation entrepreneur, shared his experiences and discussed effective planning strategies for entrepreneurship. The session concluded with an interactive question-answer session, leaving attendees with valuable knowledge.

#### Day 8

IAS Dr. Sanjay Kolte, the Chief Executive Officer of Pune Smart City Development Corporation Ltd., addressed students on July 25th, 2023. Dr. Kolte's speech emphasized the importance of skilled managers in administration, focusing on key aspects of the Smart City Project initiated by the Government of India in 2015. He highlighted the shift towards technology-driven solutions, emphasizing Information Communication Technology (ICT). The project aims for sustainability, livability, and resilience to climate change. Dr. Kolte outlined development approaches including redevelopment, greenfield development, and retrofitting. Notably, the corporation launched the first batch of Smart Buses or E-Buses in collaboration with PMPL, showcasing their commitment to innovative initiatives.

Dr. Sanjay Kolte emphasized the Smart City Corporation's focus on promoting Non-Motor Transports and public transport. He highlighted efforts to upgrade Solid Waste Management Systems in Pune, utilizing GPS technology to minimize waste sent to landfills. Dr. Kolte commended the university for organizing the Induction Program, stating it sensitizes students for their new academic journey. Additionally, he discussed his contributions to the Mahatma Gandhi Rural Employment Development Program (MGREDP).

# **Barclays Life Skills Training Program**





On July 17th, 2023, the Barclays Life Skills Training Program commenced with unexpected excitement. Mr. Prashant Sonawane, the trainer, introduced us to Barclays and Rubicon, making the session engaging with historical insights and company facts. Activities began with icebreakers like sharing our names' meanings and one-word descriptions of our personalities. Mr. Sonawane emphasized curiosity's role in progress and discussed open and close-ended questions. He delineated the transition from campus to corporate life and facilitated group activities where we analyzed departmental aims, challenges, and solutions. These exercises boosted confidence and fostered interactive discussions among participants, setting a dynamic tone for the program.

On 18th July, 2023, Students were introduced to the concept of goal setting, likened to a directional tool providing a roadmap towards their aspirations. The SMART framework (Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, Timely) was then introduced to enhance understanding. Through an engaging activity, participants randomly selected goals and applied the SMART criteria. For instance, if a student received a goal of "becoming rich," they would explain how it aligns with SMART principles. This interactive approach fostered curiosity and facilitated active learning, concluding the second day of the program on a positive note.













#### 19th July, 2023

On the third day, students were introduced to the concept of SWOT analysis, a tool for self-assessment, focusing on strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. Students learned its history, development, and application in identifying internal and external factors. Activities were employed to deepen our understanding, such as group discussions on topics like improving communication skills using SWOT analysis. Additionally, presentation skills were highlighted, covering aspects like voice modulation, body language, and language usage. The day concluded with enriched knowledge and practical insights into effective communication and presentation techniques.





#### 20th July, 2023

On the fourth day, students delved into public speaking skills and email etiquettes. They learned the nuances of writing professional emails, including the importance of elements like the subject line, salutation, and closing. Tips such as using appropriate subjects and avoiding all-capital letters were shared to enhance students' email writing proficiency. Additionally, they explored corporate jargons through a group activity, aiming to identify as many terms as possible. This session proved invaluable in refining students' communication skills and understanding corporate language.

#### 21st July, 2023

On the fifth day, students focused on essential skills for entering the corporate world. They began by learning telephone interview etiquette, including how to confirm interview details and understand the purpose of telephone interviews. Students discovered the various types of resumes and their significance in the job application process. Additionally, they explored Applicant Tracking Systems (ATS) and the emergence of video resumes. This session equipped students with valuable insights into resume building and modern job application practices.

#### 22nd July, 2023

On the sixth day, students focused on interview skills with the trainer. They learned about pre- and post-interview preparations and discussed common interview questions such as strengths, weaknesses, and accomplishments. The session concluded with a fun activity where students presented a skit on corporate life, highlighting dos and don'ts. This marked the end of the training program, offering students valuable insights into interview techniques and corporate dynamics.

### **BBABCA Induction:**

On Monday, July 24th, 2023, the Induction Program for the BBA/BCA-1 2023–2026 batch commenced with a warm welcome extended to the students by Dr. Ramchandra Mahadik, Vice Principal of IMED and Program Director for BBA-BCA, along with all the faculty coordinators of the first year.



Following the warm welcome, Dr. Veenu Shivdesani, a motivational speaker, delivered a session titled "Yes, I Can: Changing Lives." Dr. Shyam Shukla then briefed students on college activities. Dr. Shivdesani emphasized intentions, comfort zones, resolving internal conflicts, and highlighted the importance of soft skills alongside domain skills for students' holistic development. She referenced Swami Vivekanand's quote "I can do it, I shall do it, I will do it," and stressed deep listening, self-conceptualization, understanding negative thoughts, and overcoming them.

Dr. Sachin S. Vernekar, the Honourable Director, broadened students' perspectives with insights from various philosophical and real-life experiences. He discussed the stages of personality development, emphasizing self-education in the first 25 years, pursuit of achievements in the next 25, and societal contribution thereafter. Dr. Vernekar highlighted the familial atmosphere at Bharati Vidyapeeth University and shared the history of IMED. He introduced CWTED (Community Work Through Entrepreneurship Development) and emphasized "KAIZAN" for continuous business improvement. 




