

Overview

- Most pregnancies come to term normally, without any unusual complications. However, 8-10% of pregnancies are complicated by problems with the health of the mother or fetus.
- There is a significant rise in the rate of High Risk Pregnancy which requires care by skilled personnel trained in this aspect of Obstetrics.
- This lead to the development of 'Maternal & Fetal Medicine' as a sub-speciality of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

Fellowship in High Risk Pregnancy and Critical Care in Obstetrics



High Dependency Unit Obstetrics [HDU]






Obstetrics HDU

- One of the largest dedicated 6 bedded Obstetrics HDU
- Caters to high risk mothers
- 24x7 monitoring
- Daily rounds by Senior Consultants in High Risk Pregnancy
- Dedicated resident posted in the HDU
- Daily rounds by Senior Professor in Medicine: Dr Prachee Mokashir who is MD [Med], IDCCM qualified.
- 6 multi-para monitors, infusion pumps and central oxygen.
- Monitoring with trained nurses with the Modified Obstetrics Early Warning Signs [MOEWS]

Obstetric HDU & ICU





- Any pregnant women can develop life threatening complications with little or no advance warning.
- The women with obstetric complications need access to quality maternal health services that can detect and manage these complications.
- Few of them need 24x7 personalized care by skilled providers trained in High Risk Pregnancy and Critical aspects of Obstetrics...


