- Developing outstanding understanding and clinical reasoning skills through exposure wide variety of case scenarios and hands on training (routine and speciality Haematology)

Eligibility and Selection of Trainee :

- Eligibility : MD or DNB degree in Pathology.
- Number of Candidates : Three per year including one internal candidate if he/she is a faculty member of Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College.
- Entrance Examination and Selection : Written test and interview.
- Training Period : 1 year.
