Overview


- Most pregnancies come to term normally, without any unusual complications. However, 8-10% of pregnancies are complicated by problems with the health of the mother or fetus.
- There is a significant rise in the rate of High Risk Pregnancy which requires care by skilled personnel trained in this aspect of Obstetrics.
- This lead to the development of '**Maternal & Fetal Medicine**' as a **sub-speciality** of **Obstetrics and Gynecology**.

Recognition of Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University, Pune.
For certification course in Critical Care in Obstetrics.

- (1) Course duration 6 months.
- (2) Maximum two candidates at a time.
- (3) Course fee - Total Rs. 1,20,000/- in favour of "FOGSI" to be sent to ICOG office in Mumbai when the student joins. GST tax will be informed in due course.
- (4) Out of this, 80% fee will be given to the centre for ICOG and 20% will be retained by FOGSI administrative expenses.
- (5) The syllabus details for this course are on www.icogonline.org
- (6) This website will advertise the recognized centers in India and the candidates directly applying to ICOG and opting for your center will be intimated to you.
- (7) Do let us know four weeks before the candidates finishes the course, so that the examination date and examiner for that candidate can be arranged.
- (8) Theory and practical will be on the same day, in the month of **July and of January** tentatively at specified center by ICOG office in a year.
- (9) Each course starts from **1st January/February** and **1st July/August** and exam will be as decided, anyone can join later but exam will be after finishing 24 weeks. The timing of the candidates prescribed in the course will be **9 A.M -5 P.M** and one day off (preferably Sunday).

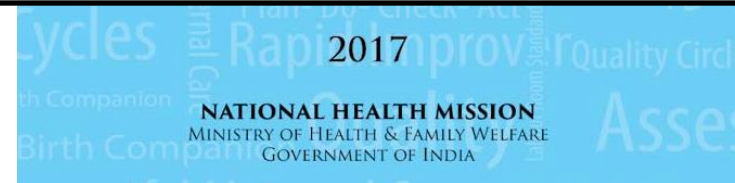
Obstetrics HDU

- One of the largest dedicated 6 bedded Obstetrics HDU
- Caters to high risk mothers
- 24x7 monitoring
- Daily rounds by Senior Consultants in High Risk Pregnancy
- Dedicated resident posted in the HDU
- Daily rounds by Senior Professor in Medicine: Dr Prachee Mokashir who is MD [Med], IDCCM qualified.
- 6 multi-para monitors, infusion pumps and central oxygen.
- Monitoring with trained nurses with the Modified Obstetrics Early Warning Signs [MOEWS]

Obstetric HDU & ICU



- Any pregnant women can develop life threatening complications with little or no advance warning.
- The women with obstetric complications need access to quality maternal health services that can detect and manage these complications.
- Few of them need 24x7 personalized care by skilled providers trained in High Risk Pregnancy and Critical aspects of Obstetrics...
