**Instructions for students**

III MBBS part II and Part I will commence from 21/6/21

II MBBS and I MBBS will commence from 1/7/21

- All students should refer to Maharashtra state guidelines with regards to RTPCR test before travelling to Maharashtra.
- Students should preferably wear double mask (Surgical & Cloth) or N95 during offline classes/clinics.
- Students should wear mask and follow social distancing during classes/ practicals/ tutorials.
- Students should maintain hand hygiene.
- As far as possible they should avoid using elevators.
- They should use staircase and should not touch the walls or any other surface.
- Hand wash/Soap will be available at all places. However, as a precautionary measure student may carry personal sanitizer.
- Students should use Non-Dominant hand for opening doors/using handles wherever required.
- They should avoid gathering in groups as far as possible.
- A student should not attend college if he/she is suffering from cold/cough/fever or any other Influenza like symptom. He/She should report to Fever OPD of Bharati hospital.
- Respiratory etiquettes are to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/ handkerchief/ flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- Students should avoid sharing of aprons/handkerchief/or any other item which may spread the virus.
- Student should **NOT** use social media for propagating fake news and should also not spread rumours that may affect college/university/society in general.
- Students should be aware of all rules and regulations stipulated by Government (Central/State) regarding use/misuse of social media.
- As per directions of Government/UGC all students should download AAROGYA SETU app.
- Student should go out only for purchase of essentials or in case of emergency.
- If students need any kind of help faculty are available.
- Even if you become sick the college and Bharati Hospital are there to help you.
- Psychiatry department of Bharati hospital also has counseling services if the need arises.
- If you become ill with COVID19 your personal details such as name, mobile number, current residential address will be shared with Public health authorities as per the Epidemic act.
- Change of Class timings:
  - III MBBS Part I and II: Clinics will be held between 9am and 12noon. Lectures/ Tutorials will be from 1-4.30 pm.
  - II MBBS: Clinics will be between 11am and 1pm (Lectures will be held from 8.30 to 9.30 am and 9.30 to 10.30 am. The afternoon lecture scheduled between 1.30 and 2.30 pm will be held between 9.30 and 10.30 am till further instructions. Practicals will be from 2- 4.30 pm)
