Faculty Development program on Teaching, Learning and Assessment of AETCOM – Focused on Phase 3 syllabus, for Clinical Faculty 12th September 2022

#### Report

AETCOM, dwelling heavily on **Ethical Principles**, is the essential addition in the CBME UG curriculum. To guide appropriate conduct of these session for UG students, MEU had organized a workshop for Phase 1 & 2 faculty, facilitated by **GSMC MUHS UNESCO Bioethics Unit**. Due to Covid situation, it had been conducted on line.

On similar lines, on request by the clinical faculty, Faculty Development Program focused on Teaching, Learning and Assessment of AETCOM – for Phase 3 syllabus was organized on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022. Dr. Santosh Salagre, Associate Professor and Unit head, Department of Medicine, GSMC, Member GSMC MUHS UNESCO Bioethics Unit, graciously accepted our request. Thanks to improved COVID situation, workshop was conducted offline, in the Hospital Conference Hall. The 30 participants included Clinical faculty and some MEU members.

The workshop was conducted single handedly by Dr. Salagre with local logistic assistance by the undersigned. Each session, highly interactive, had beautifully woven participant activities which gave them hands on opportunity to actually experience the impact of using lesser known tools like Narratives, Videos and Writing Reflections on these experiences.

Role Plays, the tool most commonly suggested by the participants for teaching AETCOM, was also elaborated upon. The need to write proper scripts and checklists for using role plays as a teaching tool, as well as assessment tool in the form of OSPE was emphasized, with hands on exposure, to actually frame the stations.

He also emphasized the need to develop a soft skills lab in the institute and enthused the participants to contribute towards it by giving group tasks to identify and describe steps towards developing the lab, generating resources for the lab and how to ensure optimal utilization of the lab.

The workshop will surely help the clinical faculty participants from across the departments to conduct the AETCOM T-L sessions fruitfully. They left the venue enthused and determined to share their workshop experiences with their departmental colleagues.
