Report – 4th Revised Basic Workshop in Medical Education Technologies

Fourth Revised Basic Course Workshop in Medical Education Technologies, was conducted at Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University Medical College, Pune, on 15th to 17th March 2021, as per the NMC guidelines, under the aegis of NMC-RC, Armed Forces Medical College, Pune. Dr. Kalpana Kulkarni, Associate Professor, Department of Pathology, BJ Govt Medical College, Pune, attended as the NMC Observer for this workshop and enriched the sessions with her valuable contribution.

Twenty nine faculty members participated in this workshop, comprising of 11 Professors, 7 Associate Professors, 9 Assistant Professors and 2 Tutors, of which 4 participants were from Preclinical departments, 5 from Para-clinical Departments and 20 from Clinical departments. Two participants had to be replaced at the last minute because of health reasons of the earlier enrolled members, while one participant could not attend the workshop because of urgent administrative commitments due to resurgence of COVID.

Considering the need for ‘distancing’ in view of prevalent COVID situation, the workshop venue was shifted to a larger Hall instead of the ME Unit premises. The arrangement and observance of all the COVID precautions were appreciated by the participants and the NMC Observer. Despite care taken by all resource persons to ensure adequate font size in view of the shift to this deep hall, readability from the furthest table was a little problematic for some slides.

Over all feedback about the workshop given by the participants both verbally and in the semi structured proforma was good, with appreciation of interactive sessions, incorporation of ‘hands on’ activities in most sessions, as well as the logistic arrangements.

Participants also appreciated the in depth guidelines given by NMC for implementation of the CBME curriculum, in terms of the phase wise curriculum documents and various modules addressing the specific components of the curriculum.

Since many more faculty members are waiting to undergo this training, permission from NMC to organize further workshops is earnestly awaited.
